The problem: The risk transmission of communicable diseases by refugees, asylum-seekers and migrants migrating to the European Union countries from the disturbed regions of the world

Proposed Approach

Disadvantaged and hard to reach groups of populations are the most vulnerable to the threats of the pandemics. Our approach will be an innovative interdisciplinary one for the improvement of the infectioous diseases surveillance systems in Europe and Turkey by developing and integrating a real-time acute respiratory infectious disease-specific sentinel surveillance particularly focusing on refugee and migrant populations.
