## Farming Innovation Programme: Research Starter Round 3. Eol

Farming, growing or forestry businesses based in England can apply for a share of up to £850,000 for feasibility projects to improve productivity, sustainability, resilience and move the agricultural sector to net zero.

## **Eligibility**

This competition is open to single applicants only.

To lead a project your organisation must:


- be an active farming, growing or forestry business of any size based in England
- be able to evidence that you are an established business, including sole traders and partnerships
- not have been awarded Innovate UK funding as a project lead within the last 5 years before 8 March 2023



## **UK registered businesses**


Use Companies House lookup as it speeds up our checks by providing your company number. You are unable to enter this at a later date.

Enter your information manually so you are not listed as a business on IFS and ensure you receive the correct funding.



## Organisations not registered on Companies House

You must register your company on Companies House before you can continue with your application. Register your company on Companies House (opens a new window).

### Exemptions

Some organisations do not need to be registered, for example:

- charities
- · local authorities
- NGOs
- partnerships
- sole traders
- trusts

If your organisation is exempt, you can enter its details manually.



## **Project Details**

- Application Team Collaborators can invite organisations who you are working with on the project. Contributors
  can invite colleagues from your own organisation to help you complete your application Lead applicants must
  complete the Equality, Diversity and Inclusion survey embedded in IFS as part of your application.
- Application Details Title, timescales, research category, innovation area and previously submitted application (y/n)
- Subsidy basis Will the project, including any related activities, you want Innovate UK to fund, affect trade between Northern Ireland and the EU? All participants must complete this section.
- Project Summary Short summary and objectives of the project including what is innovative about it
- Public Description Description of your project which will be published if you are successful
- Scope How does your project align with the scope of this competition? If your project is not in scope, it will be ineligible for funding
