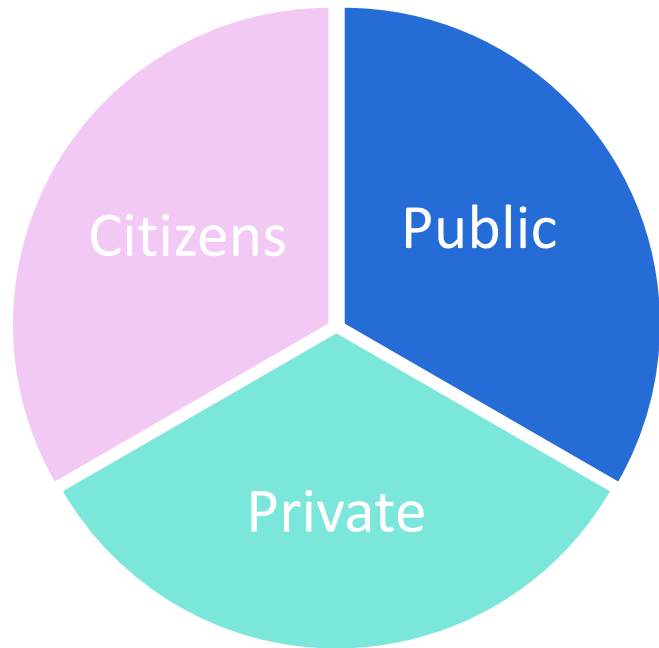

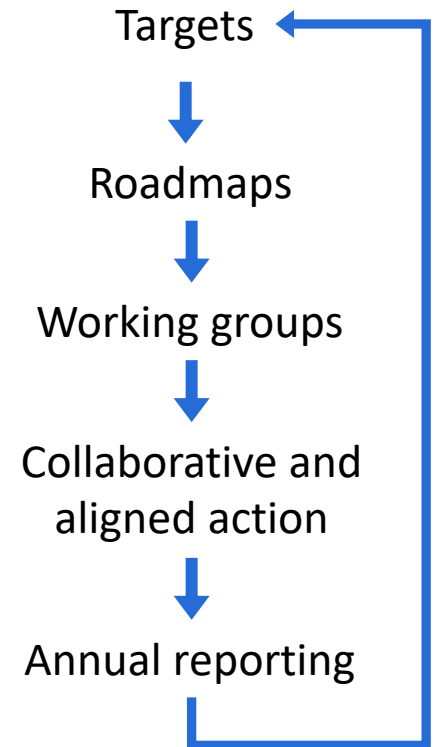


Plastics Pact framework

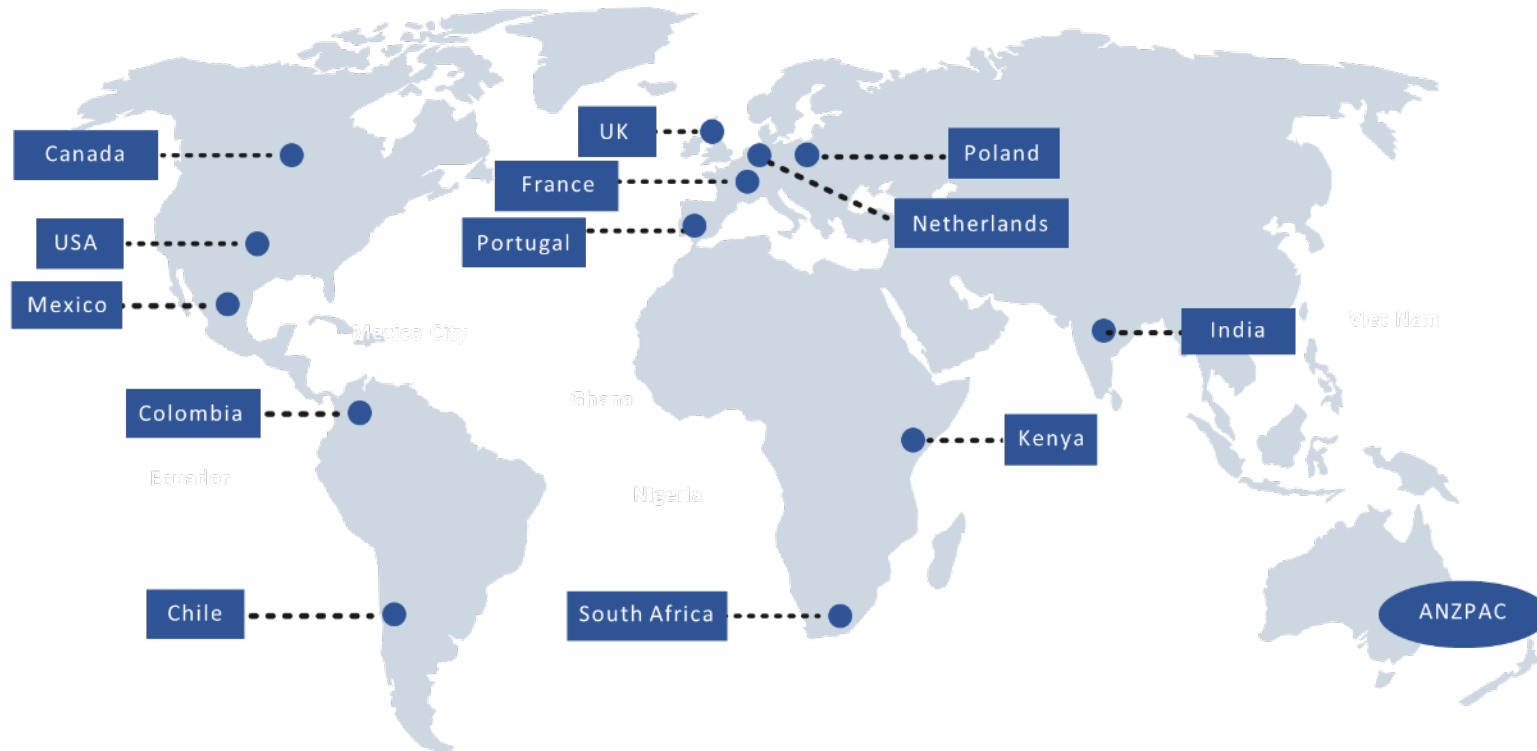
SHARED VISION

- 2 Ensure packaging placed on the market is reusable, recyclable or compostable
- 3 Increase effective recycling rate
- 4 Increase recycled content back into packaging



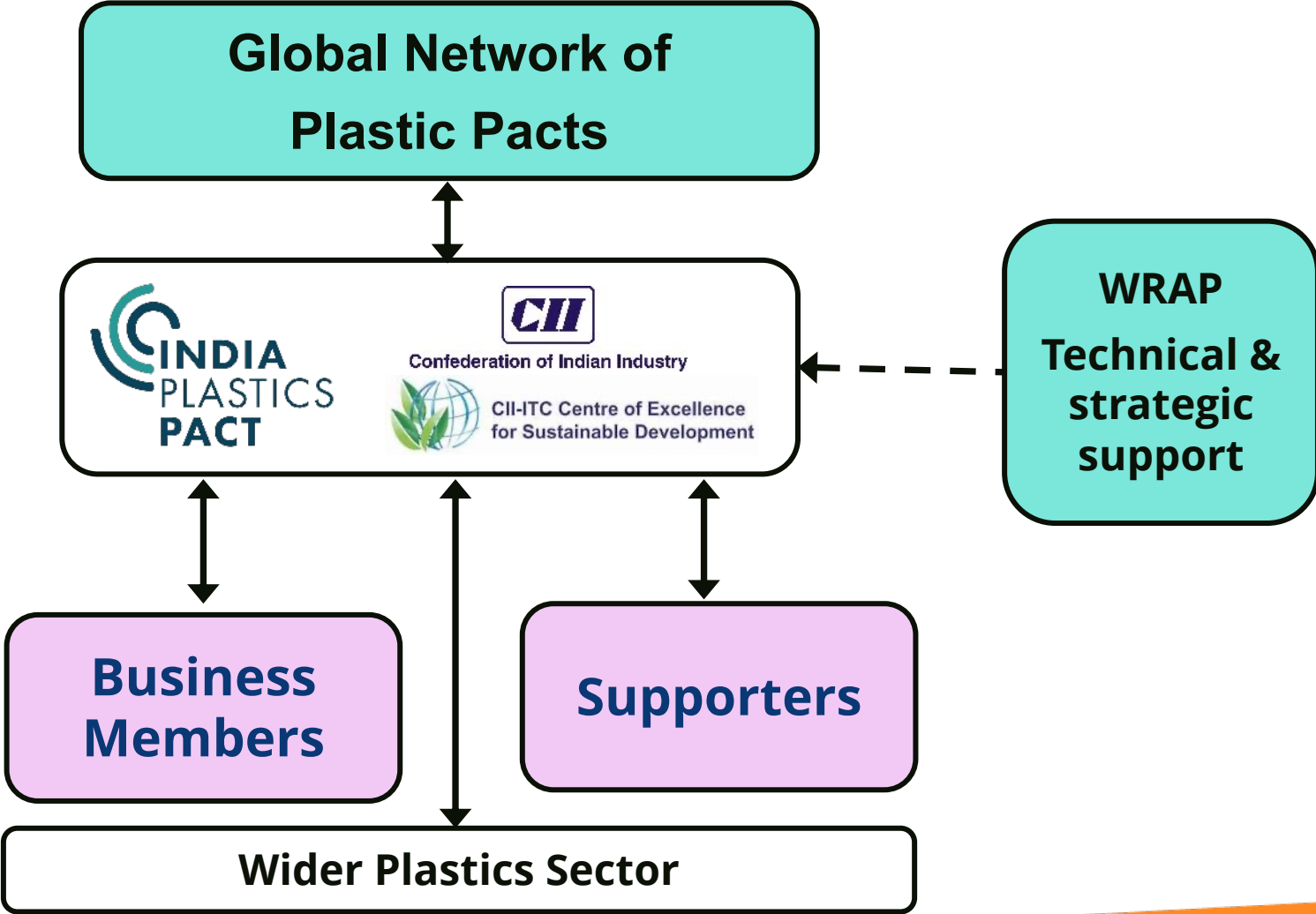
Global Network of Plastic Pacts


