help ambitious innovative UK
businesses to grow and scale on a
global stage through building R&D,
innovation collaborations and
partnerships.

The 9-12 month programme consists of a **get ready** preparation stage, a five-day tailored **innovation visit** to connect with key stakeholders and potential partners, and an **exploit the opportunity** stage to help you maximise the benefits of the programme and to grow and scale your business.

Throughout the whole programme, you will:

- Have the support of an Innovate UK innovation and growth specialist
- Explore opportunities and better understand the market
- Find potential innovation partners and develop your network
- Improve your company value proposition


Artificial Intelligence

WHAT TO EXPECT:

The Global Business Innovation Programme (GBIP) is structured around three stages. Each participating business will be allocated an Innovate UK innovation and growth specialist who will support them, including developing a work plan to capitalise on the opportunities identified. **The three stages include:**

- Get ready: Two-day workshop in the UK to build knowledge and a deeper understanding of the market and potential opportunities, including how to do business effectively, develop cultural awareness, protect your intellectual property, and support to better articulate your value proposition, important when meeting with potential partners in-market.
- Visit the market: Explore the innovation, R&D and business opportunities first-hand through meetings with key companies, research organisations and potential collaborators through pre-arranged meetings and organised matchmaking.
- **Exploit the opportunity:** An exploitation workshop and one-to-one bespoke support from an Innovate UK innovation and growth specialist to help you follow up and maximise the opportunities identified through the programme.

TO APPLY FOR THIS INITIATIVE. YOU MUST:

Be a business focused on developing innovation solutions in the Creative Industries or AI sector.

Be a UK-based innovation-led company with ambitions to grow and internationalise.

Be a company with fewer than 250 employees.

Be the CEO, founder, or a senior decision maker in the business able to attend and complete all activities.

WHAT IS THE COST?

Innovate UK will fund and organise flights, accommodation, and any conference fees for successful applicants. Innovate UK will also pay for any reasonable adjustments throughout the initiative. Only one representative from each company will be funded.

On acceptance, a **commitment fee of £1000** will be obtained from each delegate, which will be **refunded on completion** of the full activities and agreed work plan. Non-completion after formal acceptance may result in forfeiting some or all the commitment fees.

HOW TO APPLY AND GUIDANCE

To apply, please use the online application form >> Single form. The Global Business Innovation Programme is a competitive programme and applications must be made by **Monday 9th September at 5pm.**

We reserve the option to adopt a portfolio approach to ensure a wide range of businesses represented across the sub-sectors.

A business can only take part in two GBIPs in any rolling 12-month period (measured by the date of the Get ready workshop) unless there are exceptional circumstances.

If you have previously attended the SXSW conference with Innovate UK support, you are not eligible to apply.

Innovate UK is committed to improving the diversity of those we support. As such, we welcome applications from underrepresented groups.

*CREATIVE CATALYST GBIP OPPORTUNITIES

The Creative Catalyst element of the SXSW GBIP is open to **all UK creative companies** from the subsectors supported by the **Creative Catalyst Programme**.

Preference will be given to the Creative Catalyst cohort awardees (Creative Catalyst, Creative Industries Fund, Audience of the Future, SMART/Fast Start and Create Growth Programme). The intention is to have an equal split of (i) Creative Catalyst cohort awardees (ii) UK creative companies that have not yet received an award. We reserve the option to adopt a portfolio approach to ensure a wide range of businesses represented across the sub-sectors and regions. This GBIP is one of three Creative Catalyst opportunities: USA Austin - SXSW, Finland Helsinki - Slush and Singapore — Asia TV Forum.
