Global Business Innovation Programme focused on Singapore and Southeast Asia

Please provide a link to an up to three-minute video pitch, which should include:

- Why are you interested in participating in this GBIP to Singapore in particular: why now is the right time for your business to partake?
- How does your business fit in with the scope of this GBIP?
- Please explain why you have chosen Singapore as the market of choice: how will your business benefit and gain from this market?
- Has your business already engaged with Singapore e.g. collaborations and partnerships?

Your video submission has a maximum score of 40/100.

Please ensure:

- Your video is no longer than three minutes
- Your video pitch is uploaded onto YouTube or Vimeo and provide the link to either platform
- Your video pitch is available to view until 30th October 2024
- Your video is 'unlisted' in any privacy settings
- You give the link and any passwords required in your answer to this video pitch
- Your video can be **opened with the link** and any passwords and can be played before submitting your application
- You **leave sufficient time** before submitting your video pitch to create and upload your video to YouTube or Vimeo and obtain the link

Important notice: If sufficient time is not allowed, it could cause delays in submitting your application. If you cannot upload your video to YouTube or Vimeo, you must contact <u>gail.leathley@innovateukedge.ukri.org</u> **by Monday 16th September** for advice or to ask permission to use an alternative platform.

If we are not notified by this time, our team will **not be able to accept** video attachments through emails, or such platforms as WeTransfer or Google Drive.

Please note:

- A simple phone video recording upload is adequate
- Your video will be **considered together** with the responses you give to your online application questions
- The video **does not need to be a costly production**. It is simply an opportunity to give the assessors clarity in understanding your solution
- If we are unable to view your video, or it is not hosted on YouTube or Vimeo (unless we have **been notified and have approved** for you to use an alternative platform), your application will be made ineligible
